John Bocchieri is a veteran, former U.S. congressman and state senator, who currently represents Ohio's 59th House district in the state legislature, covering most of Mahoning County and parts of Stark County.

Throughout his years of public service, Rep. Bocchieri has fought to bring middle-class jobs back to his local community by sponsoring legislation to support small businesses, encourage entrepreneurship and grow the economy. Rep. Bocchieri values diverse opinions and is committed to working across the aisle to address the most important issues facing Ohio families.

Bocchieri has supported plans to expand access to healthcare, improve Ohio's public education system and afford opportunity to middle and working-class families.
