Other Federal and State Agency Changes

BMV

On March 27, 2020, Governor Mike DeWine signed House Bill 197, which states that Ohio licenses (including driver license, CDLs, and registrations) expiring during the declared State of Emergency shall remain valid until either 90 days after the declared emergency ends, or December 1, 2020, whichever comes sooner. The State of Emergency was declared on March 9, 2020.

REAL ID

Department of Homeland Security, as directed by President Donald J. Trump, extended REAL ID enforcement deadline to next year, October 1, 2021.
