Therefore, immediate action must be taken to stop these alleged inappropriate relationships and availability of prohibited substances. Staff and leadership at the Dayton Correctional Institution must be held accountable for their actions.

I ask that you conduct your own full investigation of the Dayton Correctional Institution, take corrective actions, and report back to Members of the General Assembly when these issues have been fixed. With swift and efficient action, I am confident the findings in the CIIC report can be corrected. Thank you for your time.
