MON OCT 31 - FRI NOV 4	8 AM - 7 PM
SAT NOV 5	8 AM - 4 PM
SUN NOV 6	1 PM - 5 PM
MON NOV 7	8 AM - 2 PM
TUE NOV 8	6:30 AM - 7:30 PM

VOTING EARLY

If you vote early, you don't need to have an ID, just the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.

AT THE POLLS

- Your student ID and out-of-state driver's license are **NOT** accepted, but your Ohio license with an old address is accepted.

- A utility bill, paycheck, State ID, military ID or other government document also works.

- Public university students: A letter from your university with your name and campus address on it is acceptable ID.

- Private college students: Your university can send you a "zero balance" utility bill and this is acceptable ID.
