Note: Even if you've moved from where you are registered, you can still vote! Vote where you live now.

YES! ACCEPTED OHIO VOTER ID

- ✓ **Ohio driver's license** - even with an old address, but it can't be expired
- ✓ **State of Ohio ID** - even with an old address, but it can't be expired
- ✓ **Utility bill** - current with name and address
- ✓ **Bank statement** - current with name and address
- ✓ **Paycheck** - current with name and address
- ✓ **Other government document** - current with name and address
- ✓ **Military ID** - even if it's expired

"Current" means the document is dated within the past year.

NO! NOT VALID ID FOR VOTING

- ✗ College ID card
- ✗ Out-of-state driver's license
- ✗ Passport
- ✗ Voter registration card

College ID - special notes

In addition to the above IDs:

- Public university students - a letter from your university with your name and campus address on it is acceptable ID.
- Private college students - your university can send you a "zero balance" utility bill and this is acceptable ID.

DON'T LEAVE WITHOUT VOTING: Do not leave the polls without at least casting a provisional ballot.

POLL HOURS ON ELECTION DAY: Polls are open 6:30am to 7:30pm on Election Day. If you're in line by 7:30pm, you can vote.
