



Who is eligible?

Beginning March 29, 2021 Ohioans aged 16 and older with parental or legal guardian consent will be able to receive vaccine - 16 & 17 year olds can only receive Pfizer as available.

Where in Summit County can I get the vaccine?

Beginning April 3, Summit County's mass COVID-19 vaccination site is opening at the **Summit County Fairgrounds**, run by Summit County Public Health. This site is located at 229 E. Howe Road in Tallmadge, 44278.

Participating hospitals, healthcare centers, and pharmacies are also offering the vaccine. Visit https://gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov/screening to schedule at other locations.

Where can I sign up for the vaccine?
