
Throughout the month of September, I hosted a series of town halls to update my constituents and answer their questions or concerns. I have one town hall left, details can be found below.

In Ohio, employers can receive tax credits of \$2,400 to \$9,600 per eligible employee under the Work Opportunity Tax Credit. Since January, ODJFS has approved nearly 80,000 WOTC applications. This translates to a total tax credit of approximately \$192 million. Certain tax-exempt organizations also can take advantage of the program, by receiving a credit against the employer's share of

## Hand Washing Day: October 15th

Since October 15th represents Global Handwashing Day, it is an opportunity to revisit the importance of House Bill 284. This bill would impose hand hygiene education and guidelines for the patients and residents of health care facilities.

These guidelines would mandate that hand hygiene products must be available at meal times, when entering and exiting areas of the facility, where patient or resident care is provided, before and after touching a wound or medical device, after coughing or sneezing, and after urinating or a bowel movement.



## **School District Report Cards**

The Ohio Department of Education has released its school district report cards for the 2021-2022 school year. Overall, these reports show that achievement results in the State of Ohio are moving in the right direction. Below is a table of the ratings received by the school districts in my area. Schools are given a one to five rating in the categories of achievement, progress, early literacy, gap closing, and graduation, with five being the highest.
