August 8th Special Election

Issue 1 is on the ballot in the Special Election. Issue 1 would increase the requirement to pass citizen led constitutional amendments from a majority (50%+1) of voters to a supermajority (60%).

Election Timeline

- July 10: Last day of voter registration
- July 11: Early voting begins
- August 1: Last day to request vote by mail
- August 8: Election Day

State Budget

The 2024-2025 State Budget is \$190.7 Billion. The Governor has signed it into law.

Education

- SB 1- Governor taking away State School Board power
- Grades 6 -12 students to provide free feminine hygiene products
- Universal School Voucher

Health Care

- Increased Medicaid reimbursement for Dental, Vision, and Ambulance
- \$26 Million Early Childhood Education
- Medicaid lodging program for children with special needs and their families

Taxes

- Sales Tax Exemption for Baby Products
- Income Tax Exemption for Minors
- Indexes Homestead Exemption to inflation
- Increases sports gaming tax rate from 10% to 20%.

Municipal

- Increases Local Government Fund to 1.7%
- Increases Public Library Fund to 1.7%
- Removes the Good Samaritan law
- Low Income Housing Tax Credit
