During the last week of June, the Ohio House and Senate agreed to the Conference Committee Report for the Operating Budget (HB 110) and sent the bill to the Governor. A few days later, Governor DeWine signed the budget into law.

The budget was a mixed bag and far from perfect. It was a tough decision when I cast my vote. Ultimately there were several key components to the bill that I carefully weighed. Finally after over 20 years, Ohio has fair school funding and I am committed to working with my colleagues to ensure the formula will continue to be used beyond this budget cycle. Additionally, I'm pleased that my bi-partisan bill to help the trucking industry and Ohioans get their CDL was included as well. Even with the positives, there were a lot of negatives in the bill though. We have a lot of work to do yet to help all Ohioans and improve the state, which I look forward to doing the rest of the General Assembly.

COVID-19 VACCINE INFORMATION UPDATE

Ohioans 12 and older are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine. Each vaccinated person is one step closer to herd immunity. Just like Polio or Measles, we can defeat COVID-19 with herd immunity so cases won't spike in the Fall, which could cause another economic and health disaster. The Lucas County Vaccination Rate is 47.6%. We are moving in the right direction to herd immunity but need to stay vigilant.

Voting Rights In Ohio are Under Attack, and protecting the Right to Vote was a focus of mine and my House Democrat colleagues during June. During the first week of June, I joined several of my colleagues to host a town hall in Toledo as part of the "Freedom to Vote Town-hall Tour." During the event, nearly thirty community activists and local leaders stood up and testified about the importance of protecting voting rights and ensuring every Ohioan has unburdened and unobstructed access to the ballot box. I was proud to have joined my colleagues and the community in attendance that night. Later in June, hundreds of Ohioans from across the state came together and rallied to protect the freedom to vote outside the Statehouse in Downtown Columbus. As the House returns to session in the Fall, rest assured that I am committed to continuing to stand up against anti-voter legislation such House Bill 294. I am committed to pursing legislation to expand freedom to vote in Ohio and ensure every Ohioans has the right to vote and is able to cast a ballot each and every election.
