As we move further into Spring, I would like to update you on the happenings at the Statehouse. The Operating Budget was passed out of the House over to the Senate, and there are a few highlights I would like to share.

The House Budget fully phased in the Fair School Funding Formula, increased the Local Government Fund share of the General Revenue Fund, and increased Medicaid's direct care services payment rates, just to name a few!

House members are anxiously awaiting the return of the Operating Budget for Conference Committee, so we can continue to work on a budget that serves the people of Ohio.


