Funding Available for MLK Day Projects

There are grants available from ServeOhio to support community service projects organized for MLK Day. Eligible recipients include non-profit & public organizations in Ohio such as: volunteer centers, faith-based organizations, school districts, community colleges, universities, and local governments

How can the Funding be used?

• Eligible projects can occur January 1 through January 31, 2024, and may span multiple days throughout the project window.

• To support projects or a series of projects that create or improve community assets or infrastructure, such as parks, schools, senior centers, community gardens or low-income homes

through youth volunteer engagement. Projects should be collaborative in nature, involve a broad spectrum of community participants, and benefit the larger community.
