Designate 9/11 Remembrance Day Referred to

Committee in the Ohio House



Representative Lorenz (R-Powell) and Representative Gross (R-West Chester) introduced HB 389 – Designate 9/11 Remembrance Day to the House in late January. This legislation designates September 11th as a day of remembrance for the nearly 3,000 lives lost and the heroic bravery of the first responders on the infamous day.

HB 389 has been referred to the House State and Local Committee.

Economic Development Project Approved in West Chester

Resilience US, Inc., located in West Chester Township, was recently awarded tax credit funding that will result in local economic development and job creation. Resilience is a biomanufacturing company specializing in the production of novel medicine.

The Ohio Tax Credit Authority (TCA) approved a 1.9%, 10-year Job Creation Tax Credit for this renovation project. The funding is expected to result in the creation of 274 full-time positions, ultimately generating \$18.7 million in new annual payroll and retaining \$27.2 million in existing payroll.

"I am very pleased to continue to see intentional investments into Butler County," said Gross.

Visit with the HealthCare Connection


