This week I voted NO on HB 96, the Republican-crafted state operating budget. This budget is strung together with cruel and chaotic cuts with an abject failure to invest in children, public education, healthcare, and basic services – all while shoveling billions to the rich.

Republicans are delivering for the wealthy and well-connected while screwing over ordinary Ohioans. This budget gives handouts to wealthy special interests while gutting safety net services and underfunding our libraries and public schools. It's Robin Hood in reverse.

Budgets are about choices, and Statehouse Republicans chose to invest in billionaires and corporations instead of making life more affordable for everyday Ohioans. 
