

From the desk of Rep. Lawson-Rowe

Dear Neighbor,

This summer I have been out in my district, meeting with local businesses, shadowing and discussing policy and issues with municipal leaders, and, most of all, advocating for you.

During this period of recess, I want to remind you that the state operating budget, passed into law in June, gave state control of \$1.7B in unclaimed funds. Of that, \$600m is reserved for the billionaire Haslam family to build a new Cleveland Browns stadium. Unlike past uses of unclaimed funds, the budget allows Ohio to assume the ownership of abandoned paycheck and security deposits after 10 years.

To check to see if you have missing money, please visit the Ohio Department of Commerce's Division of Unclaimed Funds website here. It will give information on how to find out whether you have unclaimed funds, how you can claim them and how to submit a formal claim form to obtain the funds. You can also check the status of your claim on the division webpage. I will be hosting a town hall regarding unclaimed funds in September so be on the lookout for that announcement.

Though the legislature is on recess, my office is still open five days a week and I am still dedicated to constituent services and aid. If you need any assistance, call (614) 644-6002 or email repo5@ohiohouse.gov
