RE: Latest reveal of Children Disenrollment from Medicaid

Dear Governor DeWine:

On behalf of the Ohio House Democratic Caucus and the hundreds of Ohio children and families we represent, I urge you to act in response to the latest release of Medicaid disenrollment data for Ohio that has been detailed in letter sent to you by the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).

According to Ohio Medicaid case reports, and as highlighted by HHS, "your state has declined by 86,053 children, or 6% compared to March 2023. We are deeply alarmed by this information and urge you to adopt the policies as outlined by HHS to ensure that Ohio Children are covered.

So many of our children rely on Medicaid for health insurance coverage. No child in Ohio should go without the access to the care they need. Every Ohioan deserves to know that their family will have coverage when they need it most.

Therefore, I am formally requesting that the procedural disenrollment for children be halted for 12 months, while Medicaid works with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to adopt policies ensuring that children remain enrolled.

We cannot let any more kids suffer due to being declined coverage. Our children and our families deserve better.
